What a Subpart D citation costs in 2026

About \$16,500 per serious violation · the same amount per day past the abatement deadline · up to roughly \$165,000 for a willful or repeat violation — per violation, before injury liability or insurance fallout. OSHA raises these maximums every January.

Why now

OSHA's fall-protection emphasis program means inspectors don't wait for a complaint — an unprotected edge, a spalled walkway, or an uncertified anchor is a documented liability the moment they (or an attorney) find it. Stack a few items on one inspection and the penalty climbs into six figures fast. The assessment is free; the gap you don't know about isn't.
